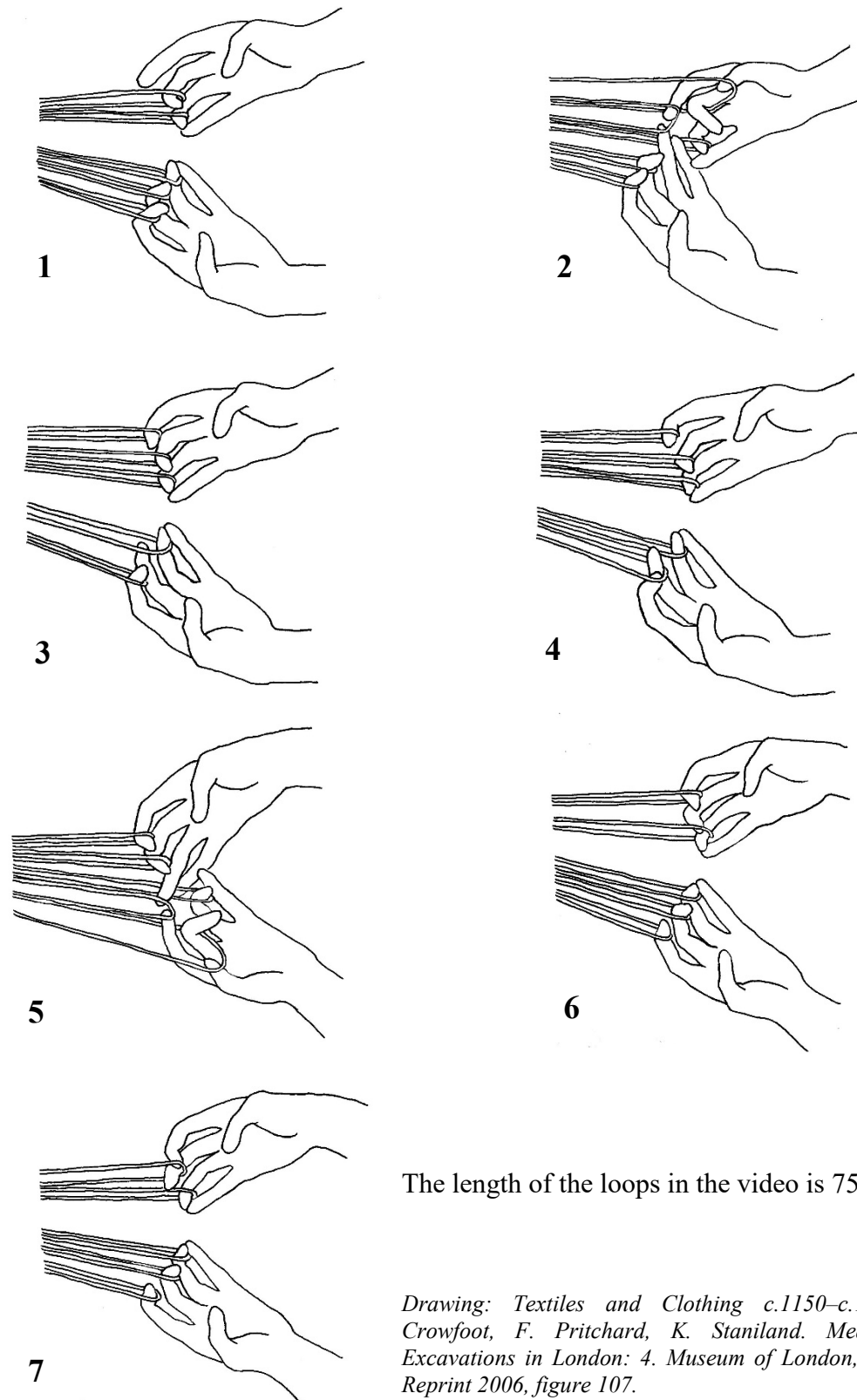

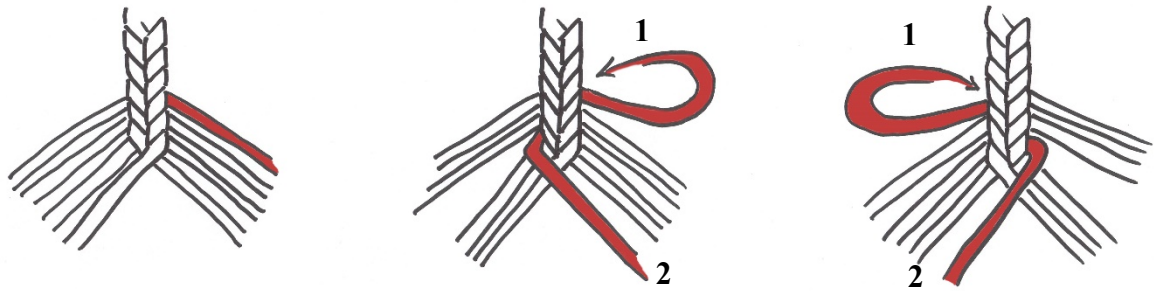
1. Making a fingerloop braid with five loops



The length of the loops in the video is 75 cm.

2. Making a square plait with eight yarns



Drawing by Astri Kaljus. Red designates a thread that moves. The middle and the right figures show the two positions of the moving thread. First, where the thread is at the beginning and in which direction it will move (no. 1). Secondly, where this thread is in the end of the movement (no. 2).

The length of the threads in the video is 170 cm.
